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Competences

- Gain cultural insights into traditions, etiquette, and customs of Portuguese-speaking regions, enhancing meaningful communication.
- Learn essential vocabulary and foundational grammar to construct sentences, ask questions, and express ideas accurately.
- Apply language skills in real-world settings, practicing Portuguese in practical scenarios such as markets, cafes, and local neighborhoods.

Methodology

This course uses a practical, communicative approach, encouraging students to actively use Portuguese in real-life contexts. Through task-based activities, cultural immersion, and situational outdoor practice, students gain confidence and authentic communication skills. Regular feedback helps refine their pronunciation, grammar, and fluency, ensuring steady progress throughout the course.

Day by day Planning

Day 1: Introduction to Portuguese

- 12.00-13.00 Cultural Session: Explore the traditional daily routines in Portugal.
- 13.00-14.00 Outdoor Activity: Go on a short city tour, describing activities in Portuguese along the way (e.g., "eu vejo uma loja" – I see a shop).

Day 4: Food and Shopping Vocabulary

- 9.00-10.00 Language Instruction: Vocabulary for food and shopping

10.00-11.15 Let's use the numbers and phrases for polite interactions.

11.15-13.00 Practical Application: Practice creating a shopping list and role-playing grocery shopping scenarios.

13.00-14.00 Cultural Session: Portuguese-speaking culinary traditions.

Day 5: Directions and Locations

11.30-12.30 Practical Application: Pair up and practice asking for directions and finding landmarks.

12.30-13.00 Cultural Session: Introduction to famous Portuguese-speaking cities and sites.

13.00-14.00 Outdoor Activity: Scavenger hunt around a local neighborhood where you practice giving and following directions in Portuguese.

10.00-11.15 How to use verbs related to family activities.

11.15-12.30 Practical Application: Describe your family and relationships.

12.30-14.00 Cultural Session: Discuss family values in Portuguese-speaking countries.

Day 7: Leisure Activities and Hobbies

9.00-10.00 Language Instruction: Vocabulary for hobbies and free-time activities

10.00-11.00 Practice with the present continuous tense.

11.00-12.00 Practical Application: Talk about your favorite hobbies and ask others about theirs.

12.00-13.00 Cultural Session: Popular hobbies and sports in Portugal and Brazil.

13.00-14.00 Outdoor Activity: Join a simple outdoor group activity like soccer or a local game to practice hobby-related vocabulary.

Day 8: Travel and Transportation

9.00-10.00 Language Instruction: Vocabulary for travel and modes of transportation.

10.00-11.30 Practice your speech and use and useful travel phrases.

11.30-12.00 Practical Application: Practice booking travel and asking for transportation directions.

- 10.30- Practical Application: Describe the weather and plan a hypothetical day trip based on
11.30 the weather forecast.
- 11.30- Cultural Session: The natural beauty and climate differences across Portuguese-
12.30 speaking countries.
- 12.30- Outdoor Activity: Nature walk where participants describe the weather and
14.00 surroundings.

Day 10: Review and Practical Application
